About & History of Aligarh

Aligarh, located in the northern Indian state of Uttar Pradesh, is a historic city renowned for its educational heritage, cultural significance, and thriving lock industry. Popularly known as the “City of Locks,” Aligarh has earned worldwide recognition for manufacturing high-quality locks and hardware products for decades. The city is also famous for being home to Aligarh Muslim University, one of India’s most prestigious educational institutions.

The history of Aligarh dates back to ancient times. Earlier known as Kol or Koil, the region finds mention in several historical and mythological texts. During the medieval period, the city came under the rule of various Rajput, Mughal, and later Maratha rulers. In the 18th century, the city was renamed “Aligarh” after the construction and strengthening of the historic Aligarh Fort by the French engineer Benoît de Boigne under the command of the Marathas.

Aligarh played an important role during the Indian freedom struggle. The famous Battle of Aligarh took place in 1803 between the British East India Company and the Marathas, after which the British gained control over the region. During the Revolt of 1857, Aligarh also witnessed significant political activity against British rule.

One of the most remarkable chapters in Aligarh’s history began in 1875 when Sir Syed Ahmad Khan established the Muhammadan Anglo-Oriental College, which later became Aligarh Muslim University in 1920. The university emerged as a major center for modern education and social reform, greatly influencing India’s intellectual and cultural development.

Today, Aligarh is a rapidly developing city that beautifully blends history, education, spirituality, and modern urban life. The city attracts visitors with its historical monuments, religious sites, vibrant markets, and nearby attractions such as Shekha Jheel, Khereshwar Temple, and Teerthdham Mangalayatan. With its rich legacy and educational prominence, Aligarh continues to hold a unique place in the cultural landscape of India.

Aligarh Connectivity



By Air

Aligarh is connected to major Indian cities through nearby airports. The nearest major international airport is Noida International Airport, located approximately 50 km away, offering domestic and international connectivity. Aligarh Airport at Dhanipur has also been developed under the UDAN regional connectivity scheme to improve regional air travel access.



By Rail

Aligarh Junction Railway Station is a major railway station on the Delhi–Howrah route and connects the city with important destinations such as Delhi, Agra, Lucknow, Kanpur, Kolkata, Mumbai, Jaipur, Bhopal, and Varanasi. More than 130 trains pass through the station daily, making rail travel one of the most convenient modes of transport for visitors and residents.



By Road

Aligarh is well connected by a strong network of national highways and expressways. The city is linked to Delhi, Agra, Mathura, Noida, Ghaziabad, and other major cities through NH-91, NH-93, and the Yamuna Expressway. Regular UPSRTC and private bus services operate from Aligarh to various cities across Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, and Uttarakhand.

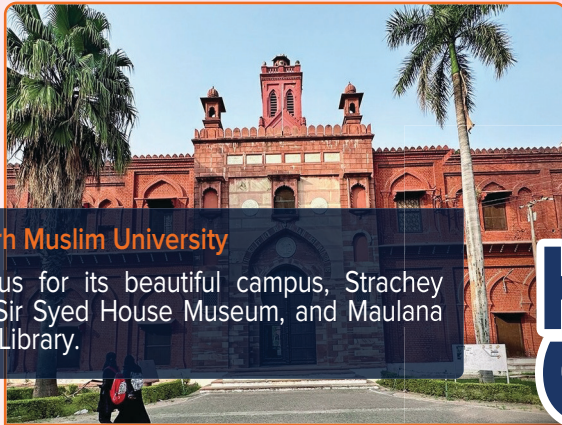

A revered temple near Achal Taal, believed to date back to the Mahabharata era.



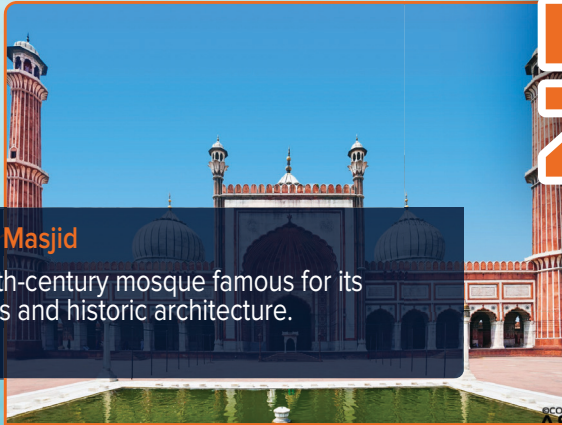
Khereshwar Temple

An ancient Shiva temple known for its unique Shivling and peaceful surroundings.



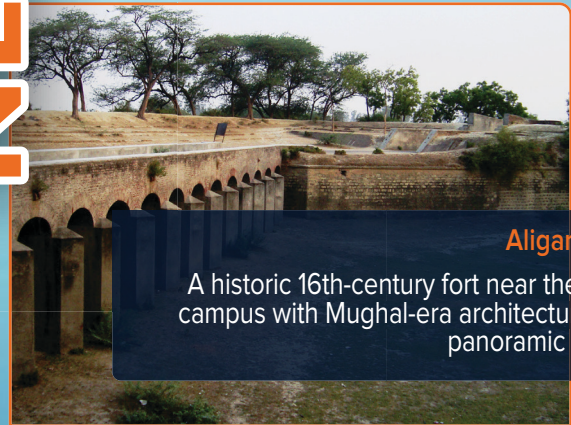
Naqvi Park
